

No-Cost Export Compliance Training Offered

ITAR & EAR for California Aerospace Companies

Many aerospace products require U.S. export licenses even if not directly exported. For example, if your aircraft component or part is assembled into another company's airplane destined for export, your product may also require an export license. It is your responsibility to determine if a license is needed and, if so, to apply for the license. Failure to comply, even unknowingly, is subject to severe penalties.

If you are concerned, want to know more, or want reassurance that you are in compliance, we have a new FREE training program to help you. It's free, because a state grant is paying us to train you.

The El Camino College Center for International Trade Development (CITD) has teamed up with the California Space Authority (CSA), with support from the U.S. Department of Commerce's Bureau of Industry and Security (BIS), to offer the free export compliance training. The training will be conducted by specialists with expert knowledge of the State Department's International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR) and the Commerce Department's Export Administration Regulations (EAR).

A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE TRAINING:

Through this training you will acquire a distinctive applicability of ITAR to your company's export operations that provides an analysis and straightforward interpretation of the regulations - 22CFR (Code of Federal Regulations). Focus is placed on business units dealing with contracts, legal, customer service, material planning, shipping, sales and order entry.
